

Beginner Obedience

Designed for pet owners who are seeking well-behaved companions. Recommended for dogs 4 months and older, but puppies can be accommodated. This class is focused on basic obedience skills such as sit, come, walking on a loose leash, manners, etc. Attention will be given to your specific concerns. This course will master basic obedience skills and encourage a more enjoyable, safe relationship between pet and owner.

Length of Course: 6 weeks

Advanced Obedience

For owners wanting more advanced skills such as working with distractions, sit and down stays at a distance, gaining off leash control, fun jumps and retrieving. This course is a continuation of our Beginner Obedience and will continue to develop basis skills with more attention being spent on focus and listening skills.

Pre-requisite - Beginner Obedience or equivalent

Length of course: 6 weeks

Rally Obedience

Rally-O is a relatively new sport having been sanctioned with the Canadian Kennel Club in 2007. Rally is a fun way for you and your dog to learn to work effectively as a team while enhancing and even learning your obedience skills. In this course you will learn the various signs (such as sit, down, weave) and rules as outlined by the CKC and UKC. Each week you will learn a different course to keep this class new and challenging. You and your dog will have so much fun you might even be tempted to enter a rally trial!

Pre-requisite: Must be able to walk on a leash

Length of course: 6 weeks
