Rules and Regulations

Thank you for choosing our day care. We are a very different day care in many ways. Please read below before submitting your application to ensure we are the right fit for you and your dog.

- We will redirect barking in a positive manner; however incessant barking will not be tolerated.
- Dogs are corrected with four consistent methods. They learn to respect our non-aversive methods.
- If arousal levels get too high, we have several calming methods to use, as a last resort we will use one of our spacious holding pens for calming time-
- Please feed your dog's prior to coming to daycare, the only reasons we can allow them to eat at daycare is if they are young puppies or if they are on a special diet.
- Please choose your attendance days and attend the same day(s) every week. Days can be booked a month in advance for shift workers. Failure to miss two weeks of day care will result in removal from the pack. Vacation time is not included in this two week rule; please just let us know ahead of time. Routine is truly important for our dogs!
- After submitting required days, if you would like your dog to attend on an unscheduled day, it is mandatory to please call prior to coming to daycare to ensure there is space and the pack is compatible. (Sorry no drop-in service available) Keeping our dogs in a routine with their daily packs makes their day more fun and predictable, which is very important in a daycare setting.
- Your dog must have a quick release collar in day care to ensure safety to themselves and the other dogs during play. (If unsure of what a quick release collar is please ask Julie at your assessment).
- A flea and tick treatment is HIGHLY RECOMMENDED at our daycare to ensure our dogs don't transmit fleas and ticks to each other, but predominantly to curb the chances of a lice outbreak, these can be common in Alberta. – (Julie can give you more info regarding the treatment). Just like children in a daycare setting, our dogs are susceptible to lice and other parasites, this once a month, topical application can protect your dog!

The difference between dogs and school age children is that there is a product for dogs that can be applied to ensure they don't get lice as opposed to the product for children to get rid of the lice after it has already become a problem.

- Just like school age children (it is unlikely but) our dogs can get sandy, wet, and/or dirty at daycare depending on the weather/climate and what toys we have brought out to play with throughout the day (i.e. the swimming pool). We will do our best to keep them as clean as possible!

I plan to bring my dog(s) on these days for day care. I understand that I must commit to these days every week or submit a monthly schedule. Thank you for your understanding in the importance to maintaining routine, it also allows us to be able schedule staff to ensure dog to staff ratios are acceptable.
